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
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#### HAPPY NEW YEAR VESTA MEMBERS

#### HAND SANITIZER DENIALS REVERSED

After months of advocacy, the district has changed its' position and will now be making hand sanitizer available to all classes regardless of whether there are sinks in classrooms or not. This is an acknowledgment of the fact that even though teachers are committed to teaching hand hygiene and incorporating hand washing into their class routines, and that hand sanitizer does not replace hand washing, there are times when it needs to be provided for student use.

The JOHS committee remains your mechanism for solving problems if hand sanitizer is not made readily available.

#### <u>FSA</u>

While efforts remain underway to have the FSA cancelled for this and future years, if the FSA does go ahead, new information has been posted <u>here</u> and <u>here</u> on the VESTA website including translated versions.

Remember that you can give FSA information directly to parents, or send them home with students, provided that they are addressed to parent and in a sealed envelope or folded and stapled.

## **Reporting Guidelines**

VESTA has worked with the VSB to clarify reporting guidelines for teachers regarding Option 4 students and for Resource Teachers whose regular programming has been interrupted by failures to fill. These provide clearer advice, but provide a great deal of space for teacher autonomy and judgment. Colleagues, this fall has been more challenging than anyone could have expected.

We urge VESTA members to seek balance and remember that reporting is just a snapshot, and only one of 5 opportunities to communicate student progress to parents. The key things to keep in mind are that:

- You cannot evaluate something you didn't teach or weren't able to assess
- Reporting needs to reflect service
- Option 4 students should have the district standard comment.
- There may be some aspects you can report on, such as participation in online check-ins.
- If you do not have sufficient information to use the proficiency scale sliders, then include anecdotal comments as appropriate
- Updated guidelines provide support for teachers with Option 4 students, or students who are registered for in-class but not attending, and for resource teachers
