VESTA has approved funding for 25 members to be released for the half day to attend each of these sessions and they take place on the afternoons of June 16 and 23.

Petition for Truth and Reconciliation Inservice

As you already know, the bodies of 215 murdered Indigenous youth and children were revealed at the former Kamloops Indian Residential School on the territory of the Tk'emlúps te Secwepemc. As settlers we have to dig deep and ask ourselves, what role has education played in the genocide of Indigenous peoples across Turtle Island? It is only when we confront and accept the truth, that we can move forward in Reconciliation.

The Anti Oppression Educators Collective has issued an open letter calling on the Ministry of Education to implement two days next school year for mandatory in service to read the Truth and Reconciliation Commission report and the United Nations Declaration on the Rights of Indigenous Peoples.

It is integral for settlers in the education system to read, learn and reckon. The demand in the petition is not on our Indigenous colleagues, for far too long they have carried the burden of settler education and the trauma and continual oppression of colonization.

You can read the open letters on www.aoec.ca, and sign the petition. Please amplify by having a conversation in your school communities and by sharing this petition in your network.
